



# KOC 2021 COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## Daily Health Check for Players, Coaches, Referees, Spectators, and Staff

1. Have you or anyone in your household had any contact with a person confirmed or suspected to have COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
2. Have you or anyone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 through a diagnostic test in the past 10 days?
3. Do you have a temperature greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit?
4. Do you have any of the following symptoms? Cough, shortness of breath, troubled breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, diarrhea, vomiting, headache, night sweats, headache, runny nose, sore throat, or a new loss of taste and/or smell?
5. Is anyone in your household awaiting the results of COVID-19 diagnostic test that is NOT random (i.e., school, work, etc.)

**IF YOU ANSWER “YES” TO ANY OF THE QUESTIONS ABOVE – STAY HOME**

## ON PREMISES – FIELDS, PARKING LOTS, ETC

- Coaches, Spectators, and Staff must **ALWAYS** wear masks when on premises.
- Players and referees must **ALWAYS** wear masks except when actively engaged in game play.
- Teams will be located on the same side of the field in designated areas. Spectators will be located on the opposite side of the field, or other areas that may be identified by tournament staff for viewing.
- Social distancing must **ALWAYS** be observed on both **TEAM** and **SPECTATOR** sidelines
- Teams are limited to **ONE** spectator per player in accordance with NYC Parks requirements.
- Team benches/tents are **NOT** permitted at the tournament.
- Players should provide their own individual hydration – **NO** sharing of water or other beverages.
- Intentional hand contact, including but not limited to high-fives and post-game handshakes is not permitted.
- Coaches, Players, Spectators, and Referees are encouraged to use hand-sanitizer throughout the competition but are responsible for providing their **OWN** sanitizer

**MSC** reserves the right to remove any coach, player, spectator, or staff member from the tournament who appears symptomatic, febrile, unwell, or is otherwise in violation of the safety guidelines presented in this document.

## POST TOURNAMENT CONTACT TRACING
